



2018 RAPPAHANNOCK CUP REGATTA RRYC Notice of Race

Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 15 & 16 2018

Description: The Regatta will consist of up to three round-the-buoy races sailed on the Rappahannock River above the bridge at White Stone and downstream of Towles Point (Rappahannock River “R-6”). Two races are scheduled for Saturday and one race for Sunday. In the event two races cannot be sailed on Saturday the Race Committee will attempt to run two races on Sunday. There will be two Classes, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker.

Eligibility: Any yacht on the RRYC or YPRCC Fleet Registry is eligible to compete. For boats without a valid rating certificate the rating will be as agreed to by the Fleet Captains from YPRCC and RRYC. To race in this event, boats must be owned and skippered by a member in good standing of either RRYC or YPRCC.

Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Constitution and Bylaws of the Rappahannock River Yacht Racing Fleet except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions for this regatta.

Entry: Entry form available on RRYC website www.rryc.org . Hand to Race Committee at Skippers’ Meeting or on Committee Boat 15 minutes prior to first warning signal. Boats may not change class once entry is submitted.

Schedule: *Saturday* - Registration at 0800 at RRYC Clubhouse followed by Skippers’ meeting at 0830. Spinnaker Class warning signal at 1030 followed by the Non-Spinnaker Class warning signal at 1035. Second race will start soon after the last boat in the previous race finishes. *Sunday* – Spinnaker Class warning signal at 1030 followed by the Non-spinnaker Class warning signal at 1035. A second race, if needed, will start soon after the last boat in the first race finishes.

Scoring: Scoring will be in accordance with the By-laws of the RRYRF Constitution and by-laws. The Least Fleet size for the clubs is 2 spinnaker and 3 non-spinnaker

boats. Scoring for the Rappahannock Cup competition will be in accordance with the RRYRF Bylaws and Constitution. Should a club not have Least Fleet Size, each boat short shall receive a score equal to the series registrants plus 1.

Appeals: Are denied IAW RRS 70.5 and the Notice of Race for this Regatta.

Awards: Individual Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places in Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker will be awarded. They will be given after Sunday's race(s) at the RRYC clubhouse. The Rappahannock Cup will be awarded to the club that wins the regatta series.

Breakfast: A full breakfast will be served on Saturday and Sunday at 0800 in RRYC clubhouse.
